By the consent of the learned Advocates  
for the parties, the following order is passed:

The petitioner has filed a suit in the  
Court of Senior Sub Judge, Rewari, titled Shri Thakur Dass  
son of Shri Pyare Lal Vs. (1) Swami Uma Bhartiji;  
(2) Shri Subhash Sharma (3) Shri Sushil Kumar; and  
(4) Shri Ashok Kumar, for declaration as well as  
permanent and mandatory injunction. On 30.5.1995, the  
defendants in the suit were restrained from alienating  
the suit property till 17.7.1995.

The receiver appointed by the S.D.M., Rewari,  
vide Annexure P-9, shall continue as if he was appointed  
as a receiver by the civil court in the above-mentioned  
civil suit. Of course, it will be open to the civil  
Court to decide whether same receiver should be continued  
or some other receiver should be appointed in his place.  
The said receiver shall continue till any other order  
regarding possession is passed by the civil Court.

The proceedings before the S.D.M. stand  
terminated by this order.

In case the suit is withdrawn by the petitioner,  
the possession of the said property with the receiver  
shall continue till specific order is made by the  
civil Court regarding the same.
